ONLINE ENTRY: www.directathletics.com This must be completed by **Tuesday, September 30th, 2014**. Return the team entry form and verification by September 19th, 2014. Can switch athletes in different races on race day.

AWARDS: For All Races:

- **Championship:** 1st through 5th place.
All other races: 1st through 3rd place team members (seven runners each) will receive Salesianum Invitational t-shirts and a trophy bowl.
- First twenty runners in each Varsity race will receive medals; first fifteen runners in other races will receive medals.
- An Award presented to the fastest overall boy and girl of the day.
- Awards presented after the day's final race.

T-SHIRTS: Salesianum Invitational t-shirts will be available for purchase on race day for \$15.00.

ENTRY FEE: Cost is \$100.00 (One Hundred dollars) per Varsity team. Teams in other sections are \$50.00 total for all JV/Freshman races. The maximum total entry fee per school is \$150.00 per gender. This would cover a girls or boys varsity team and any two or more teams in the other races.

We will use the NEW 2010 Course

The cross country course at Brandywine Creek State Park was re-designed in 2010, providing a safer running surface while maintaining all of its challenge. The starting area permits a full invitational field to line up, and crosses a large open grass area. After the first two loops the course heads directly left, not down the hill as in previous years. It moves towards the bottom of Maintenance Hill and circles around to go back up. The course then follows the same trail as before until it gets near the finish area, when the runners will circle the meadow area above the finish line. All turns are clearly marked with posts. The mile and two mile points are marked. The course crosses paved roads at only two brief points. Spectators will have an excellent view of the starting line and the finish area. A course map is provided at our meet website and on www.N5CTA.com.

- ***Please state if you believe your team should be considered for the Championship Race. Event assignments will be determined by the meet directors.***
- ***There will be an alumni/open race at 11:00 a.m. Day of registration for this event.***

The course will be open until 12:30 for touring on the day of the race and is accessible for review before race day. About 100 school teams enter and about 1000 runners compete. There are usually about twenty teams in each race. Complete results through 2013 are available at www.N5CTA.com, under "Cross Country".
